The Ocean State Dining Program, which serves hot luncheons to elderly residents at 10 sites in the east bay, is offering the opportunity to provide a week (five) or a month (20) meals at the meal site of choice. Whether a gift recipient regularly visits the meal site, or has never attended the noon time lunches, this will be a welcome gift, for these luncheons receive excellent reviews from the participants in the program. The suggested donation for a week of lunches is \$15, while a month (4 weeks) of lunches is \$60.
