Even Start is a federal program administered through the Rhode Island Department of Education that provides General Education classes (GED) and English as a Second Language classes to adults with children. Also offered are workplace literacy classes, parenting workshops, and early childhood education, as well as computer and employment readiness skills training.

Each year the Youth Center provides academic skills training and employment/career support for roughly 400 youth, ages 14-24, who reside in the East Bay region. Services vary depending on the participant's needs, and may include: tutoring, work readiness training, internship placement, unsubsidized job placement or long-term occupational skills training.
