IDENTIFICATION: ID or proof of address for the pantry; Everyone is welcome for the meal site.

HOW OFTEN CAN SOMEONE VISIT: 2x per month for the pantry; every day for hot meal; one meal per day per person for the community kitchen.

HOW TO SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT: No appointment is needed during pantry hours but you can call if you have an urgent food need outside of those hours. Please use the entrance on Dorr Ave.
